

Contingency Plan for Remote Learning.

Introduction:

Wingrave Preschool recognises the importance of maintaining our positive links with children and families if they are advised to self-isolate due to COVID-19. If parents or children are unwell, they may not feel able to use the activities and this is acceptable, as preschool is not statutory. For those that would like some support here is what we can offer:

To enable teaching and learning to continue as effectively as possible during the need for remote learning:

- We will contact parents through Baby's Days
- Supply a list of web sites for learning and fun.
- • Monitor Baby's Days and update next steps regularly.

Our staff will:

- Learning activities will be on baby's days under next steps, as appropriate for each individual child's needs.
- Provide feedback to children and families whilst they are working at home.
- • Regularly update children's next steps on Baby's Days.

Parents are responsible for:

- Spending time with their child to enjoy some of the activities together if you are fit and well.
- Reading all communications that come from the preschool to ensure they are fully aware of new ideas and information.
- Supporting their children to engage in many of the activities shared.
- Liaising with preschool staff and seeking support on behalf of their child when needed. This may be directed at their Key Person through baby's day and can be anything to do with your child.
- Ensuring courtesy and politeness to any member of staff within any communication

How to access learning opportunities:

- Access is mainly through Baby's Days and your individual children's next steps.
- Further information and website links can be found via our website.
- If parents are not able to use Baby's Days, please ask for support or paper copies.

Vulnerable and Key Workers

Staff will keep in contact with vulnerable families throughout any partial or full closure. Places will be offered to both groups of children in the event of a lockdown, if this is still possible. These may be with reduced hours or on a part-time basis. The preschool manager will also maintain the links with other professionals.
